

Holidays and Noninstructional Days

1. District personnel shall be contracted for a certain number of workdays, not including holidays.
2. Personnel shall perform contracted work in order to be compensated, unless given paid leave.
3. School holidays are not paid leave.
4. School holidays may vary from national, state, and religious holidays.
5. School personnel shall be assigned noninstructional duties on those days and at those times students are not in attendance.
6. Noninstructional duties may include professional development and other duties as assigned.
7. The Superintendent may delay the opening of school, close school early, or close school for an entire school day due to weather or other hazard.
 - a. If students are dismissed early, all personnel shall continue to work their regular hours unless directed otherwise by the Superintendent,
 - b. When schools are closed for an entire day,
 - i. classroom teachers shall not report to work, and they may be required to work another day later in the contract year to make up for the lost instructional day
 - ii. administrators, supervisors, secretaries, custodians, maintenance personnel and other personnel on 12-month contracts shall report to work as soon as possible unless directed otherwise by the Superintendent.
