The Georgia Department of Education recently released the 2018 College and Career Ready Performance Index scores (CCRPI) for all Georgia schools. CCRPI is a comprehensive school improvement, accountability, and communication platform for all educational stakeholders that will promote college and career readiness for all Georgia public school students.

The Chattahoochee County School System is pleased to announce that scores for Chattahoochee Education Center, Chattahoochee County Middle School and Chattahoochee County High School all increased for 2018. CCEC's score of 74.3 ranks near the top of all elementary schools in the RESA district. The score of 75.3 for CCMS is a 23-point increase over last year's score and is less than one point off the state average. The CHHS score of 80.9 exceeds the state average and ranks it fourth of 24 high schools in the RESA district. Lastly, the overall score of 77.9 for the Chattahoochee County School System exceeds the state average and ranks first of the 15 school districts in the Chattahoochee-Flint RESA.

These successes are a direct reflection of our school system's cohesive efforts to examine and monitor the continuous improvement process. Our amazing teachers and staff have worked each day to establish a positive culture that is conducive to learning. Our students have worked incredibly hard and have risen to the expectations set forth by the teachers. Our parents, community, and school board have supported this school system throughout our turnaround efforts. We have partnered with many different community stakeholders to provide needed wrap around services that have resulted in positive support for our students. All of these components together have led to a positive shift for the entire school system. Again, we could not be prouder of everyone involved.
