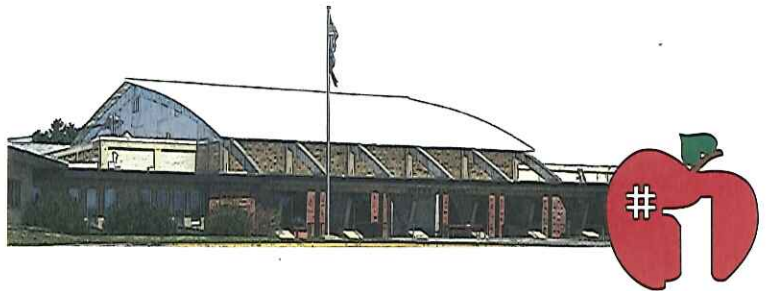

On behalf of the Dufur School District Board of Directors, thank you for your overwhelming support of the bond measure on November 6th. The support from the residents of the school district is inspiring and noted statewide. This success is just another example of the unwavering support that the greater Dufur community shows its youth.

I would also like to thank the many people that worked behind the scenes to make this success possible. The District Bond Committee was formed in November of 2017 and has worked diligently to craft the current building improvement plan. The political action committee (PAC) that was formed to provide outreach and distribute yard signs was instrumental in our successful efforts as well.

In the coming days, we will be busy with planning to ensure that the project begins in a timely manner and is conducted in the most responsible way. The district will work tirelessly with our Bond Oversight Committee to ensure that your tax dollars are used optimally.

Although the election results won't be certified as final for a few weeks, the current numbers show that 67.83% of eligible voters voted "yes" while 32.17% voted "no". Currently, there are 914 votes that have been counted. There could be a change in the coming days, but it will be small.

The students of the Dufur School District are the real winners with this referendum as the planned improvements will expand our educational facilities both here in Dufur and at the Petersburg Elementary School. As the project progresses, we will provide updates periodically through our website, social media, and through emails.
