This year, the LPA High School math department has been invited to attend the Tri-College Mathematics Contest! Students will compete in both individual and team contests designed to challenge their mathematical understandings. This year, the contest will be held at **NDSU in Fargo, MN** on **Tuesday, March 14**th, **2023**. In order to arrive in time for registration, we will leave Lake Park promptly at <u>8:00 am</u>, and we will return to Lake Park by <u>3:20 pm</u> in time for after school bus departures.
