WHAT is the ASVAB?

The ASVAB is one of the most research and respected aptitude assessments in the world. The Department of Defense sponsors the ASVAB CEP with a two part mission:

- To provide a career exploration service to US youth.
- To provide qualified leads to military recruiters.

The ASVAB CEP isn't just for student interested in the military. Participants have no obligation to talk to a military recruiter or enter military service. Students gain access to the career exploration resources after they receive their scores. Then, they can independently explore any careers that interest them, including those found in the military.

WHEN and WHERE is the ASVAB?

- 2022 Test Date: Wednesday November 16 at 08:30.
- Location: Room 212 and Mrs. Pliska's Room
- Follow Up: After scores are processed, students will participate in a Career Exploration Program and score
 interpretation. NOTE: ASVAB scores are good for 2 years for the students that decide to pursue careers in the
 military.

WHO takes the ASVAB?

- All Juniors will be given the opportunity.
- Seniors may take the exam at their own request.

HOW do I prepare and sign up?

- The entire GHS Class of 2024 is being given then opportunity take the ASVAB.
