## Considerations for December 21st Virtual Day Student Instruction

## <u>K - 8</u>

-Student virtual does NOT mean teachers prepare a lesson students must complete at home on their iPads.

-Google classroom may be utilized if home access is there for students.

-What is recommended is that K-8 students receive an assignment from each of the core areas to complete and return on January  $6^{th}$ .

-Total time required to complete the assignment should not exceed 2 hours (no more than 30 minutes per subject.)

-The assignment can be done on paper and sent home with students.

-The assignment should connect with/support/enrich standards taught in the second quarter. (Not new learning)

-This work should be graded in January with feedback for students.

-The school should send a message to parents explaining the parameters of this student work requirement.

## <u>9 - 12</u>

-High schools will need to consider 9-12 student work assignments not by content area but by larger extensions such as ACT skills, extended response writing, certification work, etc.

-Google classroom may be utilized.
