Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of the Kickapoo Area School District that on Tuesday, April 4, 2023, an election for School Board Members will be held. The candidate receiving the greatest number of votes in District 1 will serve a 3-year term; the other candidate will serve 1-year of a three-year term. The candidate with the greatest number of votes in District 2 and At Large will serve a three-year term, with all terms beginning on Monday, April 24, 2023.
