OPPORTUNITIES/BENEFITS

The Dual Credit Programs offers **4 options** for students to participate in:

1. Dual Credit Courses
2. CTE Programs
3. Designated High Schools
4. Dual Enrollment Academy Programs

The **Benefits** of participating in Dual Credit include:

- Waived tuition for most **dual credit college-level courses**
- High School **Endorsements align** with South Texas College Certificate, Associate, and Bachelor degrees
- **Enrollment & Academic Services** are offered to support students enrolled in Dual Credit courses
- Four options to earn college credit hours up to an **associate degree**
- **Transfer** South Texas College academic courses to South Texas College Bachelor Programs or other Texas public universities

SAVINGS

Since 2000, the Dual Credit Programs has served close to 130,000 high school students at 70 high school partners, **saving families over \$340 million dollars in tuition.**

In the last ten years, **La Villa ISD partnership with STC Dual Credit Programs has saved students and their families \$1,288,891.41.**

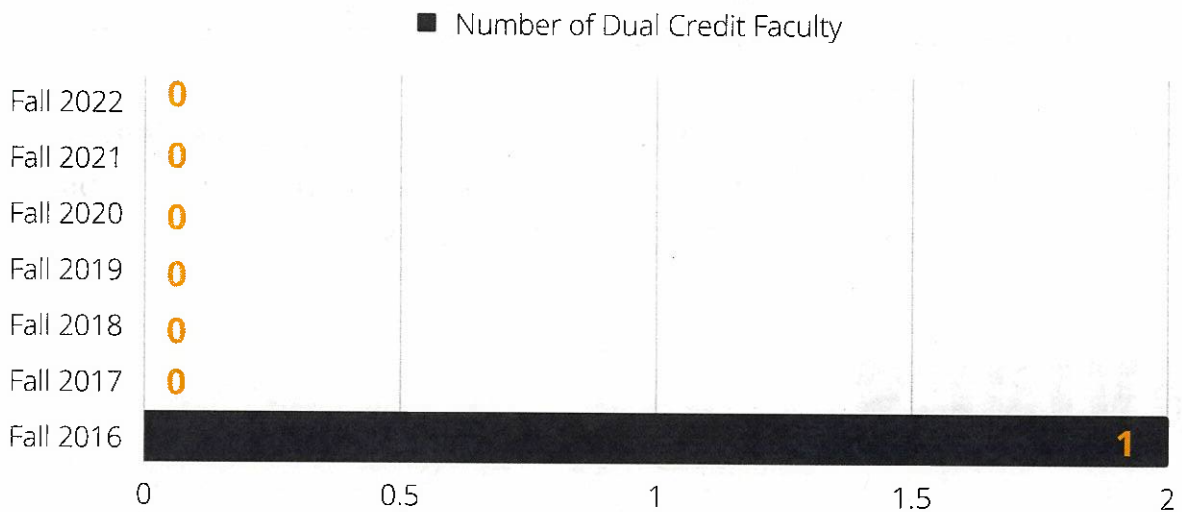

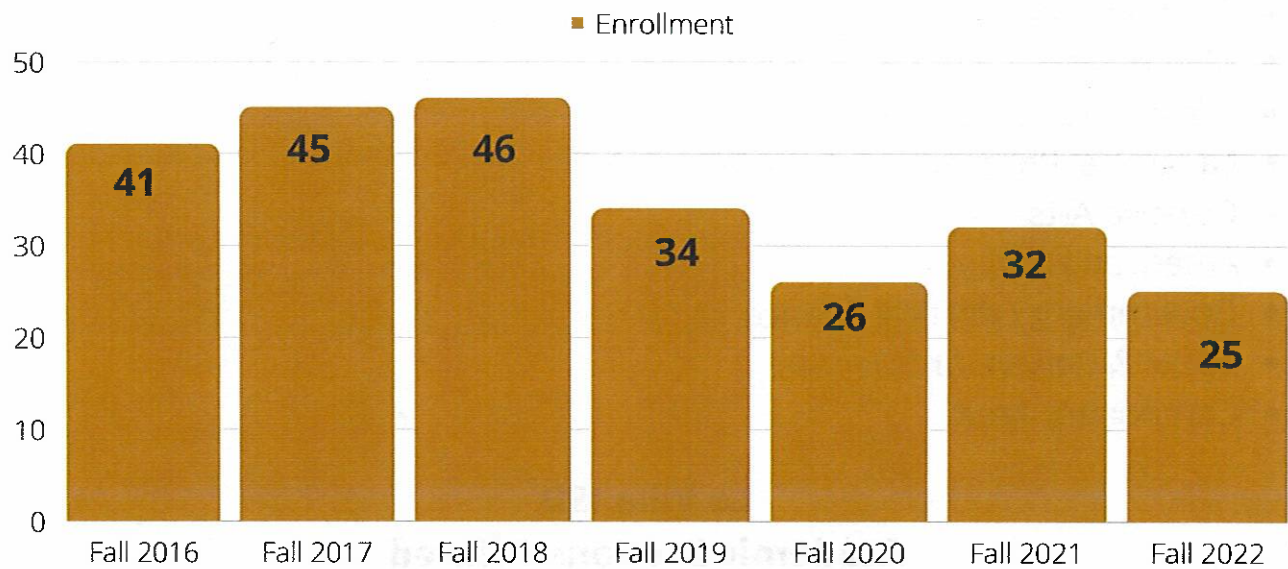
La Villa ISD Faculty Teaching Dual Credit Courses Fall 2016 - Fall 2022

Fall 2016 - Fall 2022**

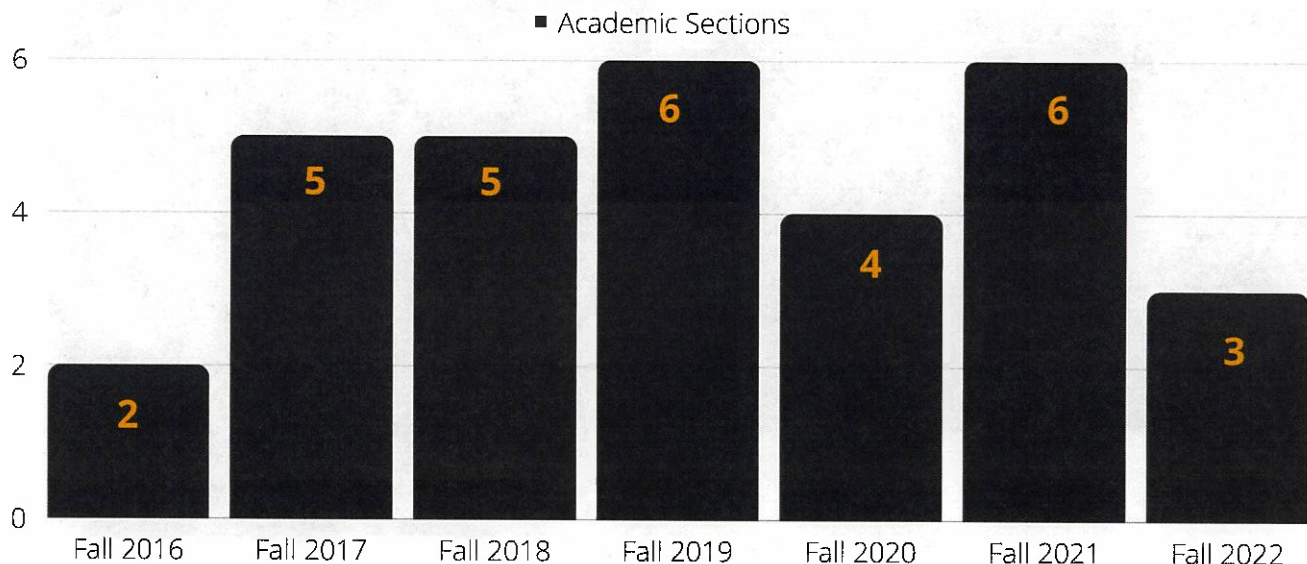

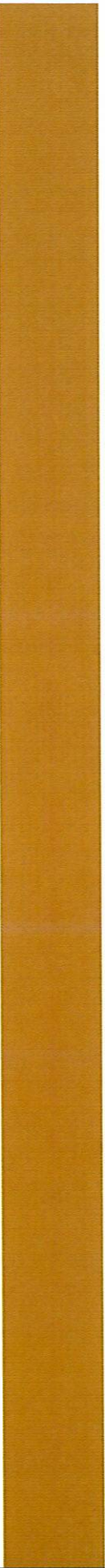
