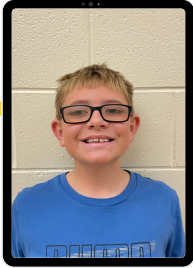


Elementary

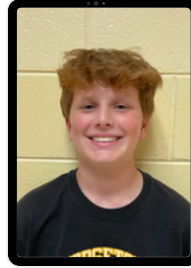
Madison Carter
