# Health Requirements for School Attendance 2022-2023

These requirements may change due to COVID-19

### Out-of-State Transfer Students (regardless of age)

Physical and eye exam Up to date immunizations

#### Preschool (only for entry to preschool, not returning students)

Up-to-date immunizations-(must have at least one dose of pneumococcal vaccine) Physical exam-on the State of IL Certificate of Child Health Examination Form Lead screening

#### <u>Kindergarten</u>

Up-to-date immunizations Physical exam-on the State of IL Certificate of Child Health Examination Form Lead screening Eye exam-(must be performed by an optometrist) Dental exam

# Second Grade

Dental exam

#### <u>Sixth Grade</u>

Up-to-date immunizations-(must have meningococcal, Tdap, and 2 varicella) Physical exam-on the State of IL Certificate of Child Health Examination Form Dental exam

# <u>Ninth Grade</u>

Up-to-date immunizations Physical exam-on the State of IL Certificate of Child Health Examination Form Dental exam

# <u>12<sup>th</sup> Grade</u>

Two doses of meningococcal vaccine, only one dose is required if first dose was received at 16 years of age or older

# K-12 Grades

Must have two doses of varicella

<u>Physical Exams</u>-Must include diabetes screening, the doctor's signature with phone number, and a health history <u>with parent's signature</u>. Sports physicals <u>do not</u> meet the requirement for K, 6th, and 9th grade. However, the school physical will work for participation in sports.

**Immunizations**-Please check with your doctor/health department/clinic to find out if your child is up to date on his/her vaccinations. You may also visit <u>www.cdc.gov/vaccines</u> for the immunization schedules.
