

Health Requirements for School Attendance 2022-2023

These requirements may change due to COVID-19

Out-of-State Transfer Students (regardless of age)

Preschool (only for entry to preschool, not returning students)

12th Grade

Two doses of meningococcal vaccine, only one dose is required if first dose was received at 16 years of age or older

K-12 Grades

Must have two doses of varicella

Physical Exams-Must include diabetes screening, the doctor's signature with phone number, and a health history **with parent's signature**. Sports physicals **do not** meet the requirement for K, 6th, and 9th grade. However, the school physical will work for participation in sports.

Immunizations-Please check with your doctor/health department/clinic to find out if your child is up to date on his/her vaccinations. You may also visit www.cdc.gov/vaccines for the immunization schedules.
