Central Community School is pleased to offer our students access to the Internet and school network system. The ability to communicate electronically, locate primary source data, and access and save resources is an invaluable part of the instructional goals of our school. Staff will make every effort to ensure students' use of the Internet and school network system is appropriate both for their age and educational purpose. All work created, accessed and stored using the school network and Internet systems is open to review by administration and staff.

Expected Network Etiquette

Students will be expected to abide by the following ~~network etiquette~~:

- The use of the district network and Internet systems is a privilege and may be taken away for violation of board policy.
- Students will not seek information about, obtain copies of, or modify files, other data, or passwords belonging to other users.
- Students will not attempt to gain unauthorized access to the school network and Internet systems.
- Students will use appropriate language in all electronic communications.
- Students will respect all copyright and license agreements.
- Students will cite all quotes, references, and sources.
- Communications may not be encrypted so as to avoid security review.
- Students will notify their teacher or other adult whenever they come across information or messages that are dangerous, inappropriate or make them feel uncomfortable.
- Students will notify the system administrator or building administrator promptly upon discovery of any suspected security breach.

Student Violations -- Consequences and Notifications

Students who violate the Acceptable Use Policy ~~and/or regulations~~ shall be subject to the appropriate action described in board policy and/or the following consequences:

1. **First Violation** - A verbal and written notice will be issued to the student's parent/guardian. To communicate the verbal notice, a phone call will be made to the parent/guardian by either the student or by the building administrator. The written notice will be mailed to the student's parent/guardian and a copy to the building administrator. The student will lose technology access for a period of up to nine weeks at the discretion of the building administrator.
2. **Second Violation** -The student, parent/guardian and building administrator will meet to discuss the violation and resulting consequences. A written copy of the violation will be provided to the student's parent/guardian and building administrator .The student shall forfeit all technology privileges for the remainder of the school year.
