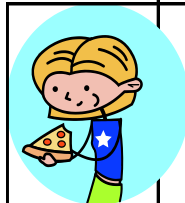
### Field Day / Color-A- Thon Volunteers are Needed June 14th

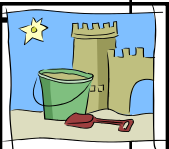
Our end of year
