Motion made by Azaldeen Mohamed and seconded by Mona Abdulla to approve the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the Lackawanna City School District has previously established Transportation Policy #5730, pursuant to Education Law §3635 that provides for the transportation of students legally attending schools outside the City of Lackawanna, as follows:

A. Transportation will be provided for pupils in kindergarten through grade five, who reside .5 miles or more from the school they attend and for pupils in grades six through eight who reside 1.5 miles or more from the school they attend to a maximum of **two miles**; and

B. Transportation will be provided for pupils in grades nine through twelve who reside 1.5 miles or more from the school they attend up to a maximum of **ten miles**, by either school bus or public carrier, at the discretion of the district; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education, after balancing the safety, convenience, efficiency, and cost, of said pupils, has now determined that it would be in the best interest of the school district to amend the current transportation policy, as follows:

A. Transportation will be provided for pupils in kindergarten through grade five, who reside .5 miles or more from the school they attend and for pupils in grades six through eight who reside 1.5 miles or more from the school they attend to a maximum of 10 miles; and

B. Transportation will be provided for pupils in grades nine through twelve who reside 1.5 miles or more from the school they attend up to a maximum of 10 miles, by either school bus or public carrier, at the discretion of the district;

Motion made by Azaldeen Mohamed and seconded by Mona Abdulla to amend the resolution to include an extension to the deadline for the 2021-2022 school year for all transportation requests to now be submitted by May 31, 2022. DULY PUT TO A VOTE ALL IN FAVOR / NONE OPPOSED Passes 6-0
