- Discuss students' tracking their own learning in math
- Discuss possibly developing a "growth portfolio" that is student-driven and travels with students to the following grade level
- Discuss sending home handouts for families at November report card / conference time... These would provide suggestions for specific things to work on for student, differentiated by skill deficit (for example, lists of books to check out at the library based on student's reading level; questions to ask the child when reading a book at that level at home; flashcards to work on for skill deficits in math; websites to use at home, etc.)
