LINDSAY WITT MOVED TO HIRE TENURED TEACHERS FOR 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR. AMBER TILZEY SECONDED. BREANN STRECK ABSTAINED DUE TO CONFLICT OF INTEREST. DISCUSSION, DISCUSSION, DISCUSSION. ALL IN FAVOR? MOTION PASSES 4-0.

  - 3110-HELPS TO ALIGN OUR POLICY WITH THE UPDATED AGE OUT POLICY THAT MTSBA HAD UPDATED.
  - 3100-THIS POLICY ALLOWS FOR EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES WITH A FOCUS ON EARLY ADMITTANCE TO KINDERGARTEN.
  - 3100P-THESE ARE THE STEPS THAT WE WOULD TAKE TO IDENTIFY EXCEPTIONAL STUDENTS MERITING WAIVER OF AGE REQUIREMENTS.

DISCUSSED POLICY AND HOW TO HANDLE CASE BY CASE BASIS. FURTHER DISCUSSION ON EXTENDING SERVICES PAST AGE OF 19. DISCUSSED STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS. DISCUSSED IEPS AND DISCUSSIONS WITH PARENTS ALSO. WE HAVE SPECIAL ED AUDITS EVERY FEW YEARS. INCLUDE ANB MONEY UP TO AGE OF 21 FOR STUDENTS. FURTHER DISCUSSION ON EARLY CHILDHOOD POLICY. 4 YEAR OLD MARK TO BRING IN. RESEARCH IS SHOWING THAT SOME STUDENTS ARE NOT CAUGHT UP UNTIL AFTER 3<sup>RD</sup> GRADE. START THEM EARLIER SO THEY ARE ALL AT A LEVEL PLAYING FIELD. IT MAKES STUDENTS BETTER PREPARED. 3<sup>RD</sup> GRADE TEST HELPS TO DETERMINE THE LEVEL. ANY FOUR YEAR OLD THAT WOULD MEET THE DATE OF SEPTEMBER 10. WE CAN USE ESSER FUNDS TO START OUT AND THEN ANB DOWN THE ROAD. CURRENTLY HAVE SPECIAL NEEDS PROGRAM WITH 3 AND 4 YEAR OLDS THROUGH THE CO-OP. ½ ANB PER STUDENT. CURRICULUM NEEDED AND INCREASE OF COST FOR TEACHER. WOULD LOOK AT TWO SESSIONS IF WE HAVE A LARGE AMOUNT OF KIDS. ONE POLICY COVERS BOTH SIDES-EARLY ED AND OLDER STUDENTS. KEY OPTIONS WE ARE LOOKING AT. NEED TO SHOW RESIDENCE. IF ANOTHER FAMILY INVOLVED CONSIDERED HOMELESS. DISCUSSION, DISCUSSION, DISCUSSION FIRST READING OF POLICY MOTION PASSES 5-0.

NOT A PRE-SCHOOL-THIS IS SPECIFICALLY FOR EARLY EDUCATION KINDERGARTEN. THIS WILL HELP OVERALL WITH HELPING OUT THE SPECIAL ED DEPARTMENT. ELEMENTARY IS 22 AND HIGH SCHOOL IS 24 IN SPECIAL ED. SAME FOR MATH AND READING THAT IS GOING TO BE USED IN K-5. THIS ALIGNS WITH BOARD GOALS. RUN \$8000 FOR ELEMENTARY, \$14, 000 CLOSER TO \$20,000. PART OF OUR MONEY GOES TO CO-OP. FUTHER DISCUSSION. HAVE TO QUALIFY FOR JUST ONE. UNDER THE STATE AVERAGE AT 3RD GRADE. FURTHER DISCUSSION ON EARLY ED KINDERGARTEN REQUIREMENTS. NOT USING SAME CURRICULUM. WILL NEED TO ACCESS THE SAME CURRICULUM AND GET ADDITIONAL HELP. LOOK AT A BASELINE. LOCKWOOD DOES SOMETHING SIMILAR. FURTHER DISCUSSION ON EARLY ED.
