## School Facebook Page, Website, and Snow Day Phone Calls

St. George MSU communicates with families and community members through a variety media, including the St. George MSU Facebook page and the school website. I wanted to share some quick information on our Facebook page and website:

This is the only "official" school Facebook page that is maintained and monitored by school staff. This is a great way to disseminate information, but please be aware that school staff do not monitor questions or concerns posted on other Facebook pages. If you do have a question or concern, please contact school staff directly with an email, a phone call, or just stopping by the school to talk.

If you receive a phone call from an Arkansas phone number early on a school day, it's probably from the school's emergency notification system. Also, when you answer the call, you need to say "Hello" - or just grunt loudly if you're like me at 5:30 a.m. - and then the message will play. If you don't say anything when you pick up, the message won't play. We are working with the company who handles our emergency notifications to address this.
