Greetings and WELCOME to Glen Lake!

Attached you will find the Michigan High School Athletic Association's (MHSAA) New Student Form.

All incoming students to Glen Lake, with the exception of freshmen that are enrolled and attend class at Glen Lake on the FIRST day of school in the fall, are INELIGIBLE to participate in an interscholastic athletic contest or scrimmage for the 2022-2023 school year in the sport(s) that she/he participated at her/his previous school, UNLESS the student meets one of the MHSAA's 15 stated Exceptions.

This is a very important MHSAA rule to be aware of as the school may be penalized by forfeiting contests in the event we use an ineligible transfer student.

As noted above, there are Exceptions to this rule that may deem a student immediately eligible, depending on the circumstance of the transfer. However, students should not join a team without discussing with the Athletic Director prior to participation.

If a student is interested in participating in high school athletics (the rule does not apply to middle school students), the attached form will help the Athletic Director determine whether or not a student will be immediately eligible OR ineligible for the school year.

Incoming students should complete the attached form, regardless of whether or not she/he is interested in participating in athletics, as we need to monitor participation in order to adhere to the rule. The form should be returned to either the Secondary Guidance Office or Athletic Office. Students who are interested in participating and want to determine whether she/he meets an Exception to the transfer rule, should make an appointment to speak with the Athletic Director. In cases of unusual circumstances, a request to waive the transfer rule can be made by the Athletic Director to the MHSAA, but that takes time. Do not wait until just before a sport of interest as time is needed to determine eligibility status.
