
NEWS RELEASE

The Prosser School District Board of Directors is seeking candidates to apply for one seat declared vacant at the April 12, 2023, Regular Board Meeting. The board seat available is for District 2. Qualified candidates for the vacant board seat can apply directly with the District, or they can be nominated by a member of the public. The term for this board seat expires on November 23, 2023. Once the screening and interview process is complete, the successful candidate will fill the position immediately upon appointment by the Board.

Director District 2

Starting at the intersection of W Old Inland Empire Hwy and N Hinzerling Rd. North on N Hinzerling Rd to W McCreadie Rd. East on W McCreadie Rd to N Crosby Rd. North on N Crosby Rd to NW Hamilton Rd. West on NW Hamilton Rd to Anderson Rd. Westerly on Anderson Rd to the school district boundary. Counter-clockwise on the school district boundary to the western crossing of W Old Inland Empire Hwy. Easterly on W Old Inland Empire Hwy to the point of the beginning.

- the candidate must be a United States citizen;
- must live in the State of Washington, and;
- must be a registered voter in District 2.

As part of the application process candidates are requested to submit in writing a biographical overview and a statement outlining their reasons for desiring to serve on the Prosser School District Board of Directors.
