

SPECIAL PROGRAMS ADMINISTRATION

The Director of Special Education shall direct and administer all professional supporting services and special programs for the entire school system. He/She also has shared responsibility with building administrators for the coordination of special services among several schools.

Special teacher services shall include, but not be limited to, psychological services, testing services, Chapter One services, physical and occupational therapy, speech and hearing therapy, special education and special education itinerant teachers.

The Director is authorized to take any reasonable action necessary to carry out his/her responsibilities, provided such action does not deviate from Board policies or from administrative directives of the Superintendent and is consistent with sound personnel and educational practice.
