SAFETY PROGRAM

It shall be the policy of the School Committee to guard against accidents by taking every possible precaution to protect the safety of all students, employees, visitors, and other on district property or at school-sponsored events.

The practice of safety is to be integrated in the instructional plan of the district by virtue of educational programs in traffic and pedestrian safety, fire prevention, emergency procedures, etc., appropriately geared to students at different grade levels.

Each principal is responsible for the supervision of a safety program for his/her school. The business administrator has overall responsibility for the safety program of the district. General areas of emphasis shall include, but not be limited to: in service training; accident record keeping; plant inspection; driver and vehicle safety program; fire prevention; school site selection; and emergency procedure and traffic safety problems relevant to student, employees, and the community.
