

FACILITIES PLANNING

As the School Committee seeks to overcome deficiencies in its physical plant, it shall strive to provide new facilities that will provide the best educational and physical environment for all students. The School Committee is committed to providing quality education, aided by school facilities that will permit each child to grow and develop according to his or her best abilities, and that will serve the future needs of the children and the community.

New buildings and renovations to existing buildings shall be in accordance with the organizational patterns established by the School Committee, and shall be designed to fit current as well as anticipated instructional programs.

For each building project, a school building committee consisting of School Committee members and six citizens appointed by the selectmen are charged with the responsibility of facilities planning.

Decisions pertaining to the construction of educational facilities will be made only after the views of teachers, students, parents, and other citizens have been considered.

All legal requirements set by federal and state law, and all regulations of the Department of Education, shall be complied within all stages of facilities planning and construction.
