The professional advancement of an educational institution depends, to a significant degree, upon the proper application of research findings. Improvements, both of management and instructional functions, require knowledge of prior and current research studies and of their implications for teaching and learning.

It is the policy of the School Committee to encourage a spirit of inquiry and investigation, and to urge the application of all appropriate research findings to instructional and managerial processes. The superintendent/ assistant superintendent is authorized to assign approved curriculum studies when desirable.
