OCCUPATIONAL EDUCATION

The Sanford Regional Vocational Center was created as an administrative entity that provides vocational-technical education opportunities to secondary students from school administrative units with which it is affiliated in preparation for employment and/or further education.

The Sanford Regional Vocational enter may include within its administrative structure vocational satellite programs operated by school administrative units with which it is affiliated.

The Sanford School Committee shall govern, administer and operate the Center in a manner consistent with local, State, and Federal regulations and policies.

Objectives of the Sanford Regional Vocational Center

1. To provide high school students with diversified vocational-technical education opportunities, at the Center of through approved Satellite facilities and programs, from the following York County school districts:

Town of Sanford
Wells-Ogunquit Community School District
Town of York
Maine School Administrative District No. 35
Maine School Administrative District No. 57
Maine School Administrative District No. 60
Maine School Administrative District No. 71

- 2. To provide vocational-technical training along with regular courses offered in the high school which sends students to the Center so that they may be prepared to enter the world of work as competent and productive members of society or go on to further education
- 3. To provide appropriate training and re-training opportunities for post graduate students and adults.
- 4. To provide appropriate special education programs that will help young people and adults prepare for employment which will enable them to become productive and independent members of the community
