

PUBLICATIONS
(And Distribution of Literature)

The preparation, publication, and distribution of newspapers, magazines, and other literature is an exercise of freedom of the press. School-sponsored publications must follow the same rules for responsible journalism as other publications. Conditions governing access to or the suitability of materials shall be subject to review and evaluation by the editorial staff, faculty sponsors, and the principal.

Distribution of any non-school sponsored materials or literature such as leaflets and newspapers on school property shall receive prior approval of the Superintendents or designee.

1. The principal will designate a specific time and place where acceptable materials may be distributed
2. Anyone distributing these materials will be responsible for removing litter which may result from their activities.

Failure to observe these rules may result in confiscation of the material, curtailment of the privilege, and disciplinary action.
