

CONTESTS FOR STUDENT

The School Committee believes the primary educational aims of the schools and the needs and interests of their students must be the most important consideration at all times. It will be a general policy for principals to deny promotional assistance, school time, or faculty assistance to pupil contests, involving essay writing, poster making or other activities sponsored by organizations outside the school.

Exceptions may be made if, in the judgment of the principal and with the concurrence of the superintendent, a particular contest involves experiences which are closely allied to and in support of the instructional work of the school and which will clearly serve to advance the educational aims of the school.
