

HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ADULT EDUCATION STUDENTS

Successful completion of the following core requirements:

1. Four credits in English
2. Two credits in Mathematics
3. Two credits in Science
4. Two credits in Social Studies (including one U.S. History/Modern History)
5. One credit in Fine Arts
6. One credit in Computer Literacy
7. One half (1/2) credit in Health
8. One credit in Computer Applications (i.e., Excel, Office Pro, ClarisWorks, etc.)
9. One Community Service Project per school year up to a maximum of four (a non-credit, non-course requirement as defined in the SHS student handbook)
10. Must be at an 8th Grade equivalent level on the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) for Reading Language and Mathematics

Beginning with the Fall 1998 Semester, a varying amount of credits will be required:

1. Students who would have graduated prior to 1989, or who have successfully completed at least two courses with the Adult Education Program, will be required to have minimum of 19 credits. This will change to twenty credits starting in the Fall of 1999
2. Students who would have graduated between 1990-1997 will be required to have a minimum of twenty credits
3. Students who would have graduated in 1998 will be required to have a minimum of twenty-two credits
4. Students who would have graduated in 1999 or beyond will be required to have a minimum of twenty four credits.
