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COURSE MAKEUP

It is the intention of the School Committee to create educational settings where every child masters the learning results we have defined by providing positive and personalized learning environments.

The School Committee is aware that the class size has bearing upon effective teaching. Students who have not successfully completed courses required for graduation may cause class enrollments to exceed preferable class sizes when the repeat those courses and could have an impact on the learning of all students in the class.

Students who fail their core courses (English, mathematics, science, social studies) during their freshman, sophomore or junior year will be required to retake those courses in summer school or during an after school makeup block. Students will not be allowed to make up failed core courses during the traditional school day.

Exceptions to this policy may be granted by the principal, with the advice of the student's guidance counselor, for hardship reasons, and if there is space available.
