COMPARAILITY OF SERVICES

The Sanford School Committee recognizes its obligation under Chapter 1 of the Elementary and Secondary School Amendments of 1988 to provide equivalence among schools, with an enrollment of over 100 pupils, in the following areas:

- 1. Allocation of teachers, administrators, and auxiliary personnel
- 2. Provision of curriculum materials and instructional supplies
- 3. Special education programs
- 4. Salary schedules

The School Committee reaffirms a commitment to the following objectives:

- 1. To provide equivalence in staffing among schools,
- 2. To provide equivalence in educational programs to the pupils of each school
- 3. To provide programs and services for students with disabilities in compliance with the requirements of applicable status

To this end, the Superintendent of Schools shall prepare and retain an annual summary, in format approved by the School Committee, which shall document the extent to which equivalence has been achieved.
