

PROFESSIONAL STAFF ORIENTATION

Orientation shall be considered a year-long process for teachers new to the system, with the program conducted jointly by the central administration and individual schools.

The program shall assist new teachers in becoming acquainted with, and adjusting to, the community, school district, and school—including policies of the School Committee, rules and regulations, and the instructional program.

Administrators, coordinators, directors, and experienced staff members shall be assigned specific roles in carrying out orientation programs.

The cooperation and active involvement of all staff members in helping newcomers become adjusted in the district is requested by the School Committee.
