Other Terms and Conditions of Enrollment

Alabama Immunization Card – This health card *must* be on file in the school office before the first day of class.

School Day --The school day begins at 8:00 with a teacher on duty at 7:30 at no charge to support working parents. School ends at 3:00 p.m. with our *Afternoon Explorations* providing instruction and activities M-F until 5:30 p.m. Children not picked up by 3:00 will be brought to the school office to wait. You may pick up earlier than 5:30 p.m. No "drop-ins" may join since yearly registration is required to be able to hire teachers in July. Call the office if you have an emergency and need help.

School Year – The 2023-24 calendar is online at www.the-capitolschool.com. To help support working parents, "Break Camp" can be reserved for \$40 per day for most school holidays.

Admission Policy & Handbook – All new and returning students must comply with admission policies, handbook and rules established by school faculty.

Parent/Teacher Communication – Required parentteacher conferences are held in August, October and March. Additional conferences can be scheduled by parent request.

Parent Service Commitment – The Capitol School is a partnership of school & family. Parents agree to contribute 36 hours per year as a volunteer. This time may be contributed weekly, monthly, or accrued for a special event such as a day trip or planning a school event. Earn hours by attending school events, Parent Conferences, chaperoning field trips or volunteering on school grounds, in Library or classrooms..

Parent Council – Our goal is 100% membership in our Parent Council. Membership is included in Capital Fee but grandparents are welcome to join for \$30 annual membership fee.
