MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS – TB TEST

All students transferring or enrolling from a school outside of this state shall have an approved tuberculin skin test done with the result read and evaluated prior to admittance to schools.

All school personnel shall furnish a certification from a licensed physician or health officer, stating that a tuberculin skin test, approved by the commissioner, has been made within four months prior to employment.

The Superintendent shall have the authority to require selective testing of students and school personnel for TB when reason for exposure exists.

In addition, transportation employees will follow the requirements as set forth by the West Virginia Department of Transportation.

In addition, food handlers will follow the requirements set forth by the West Virginia Department of Health.

The Superintendent may, if deemed necessary, require a physical examination to be secured by any employee.
