COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES AND PERFORMANCES BY STUDENTS

The Board of Education, pursuant to the authority granted in the School laws of West Virginia, has elected to delegate the control, supervision and regulation of Summer County interscholastic athletic events and band activities of the students to the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission.

Pupils of Summers County shall perform in public as representatives of the schools only when such appearances are school sanctioned with the approval of the principal and superintendent and are not in conflict with policies, rules, regulations, and resolutions of the State Department of Education and the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission.

The Board of Education expects coaches, band directors, and all others connected with the interscholastic performance of students to familiarize themselves with and abide by the rules, regulations and operating procedures which have been implemented by the Commission.

Student performances and rehearsals which conflict with class time are to be kept to a minimum. All student performances which require transportation shall be arranged between the sponsor, coach, or director, and the principal. The request for transportation shall then be submitted to both the transportation director and the County Superintendent in order that approval be given prior to the occurrence of the event.
