TEACHER AIDE

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Summers County Board of Education in the School Laws of West Virginia, the Board has hired several paraprofessionals (teacher aides). Teacher aides are employed for the purpose of assisting professional personnel, tutoring disadvantaged students, and as bus monitors for special needs students.

All aides must be at least eighteen years of age, have a minimum of a high school education, and meet pre-service and in-service training requirements established by either federal and state guidelines, or local board regulations. Employment, training, evaluation, and retention or separation of teacher aides shall be consistent with the guidelines established by federal statutes, state statues, and local Board regulations. Employment, training, evaluation and retention or separation of early childhood education aides shall be consistent with the guidelines established by state statutes and local Board regulations.
