LEAGUE DETAILS

PRACTICES/GAMES: All divisions practice one night a week for one hour. All games play on Saturdays. Junior High division games maybe scheduled Sundays if needed. League games start the weekend of January 20th. Schedules will be posted online at www.teamsideline.com/placerville.

FORMAT: Teams are guaranteed 8 games. Winners of the 3rd-8th grade leagues will receive individual awards. All participants in Kindergarten-2nd grade leagues will receive participation awards.

REGISTRATION: If a player would like to request a coach they must do so at the time of registration. If a coach is not requested, they will be placed on a team with others from the same school or the closest available area. Players who have been requested on a team must indicate so at the time of registration. Roster requests are not guaranteed, however every effort will be made to accommodate requests received prior to the registration deadline.
