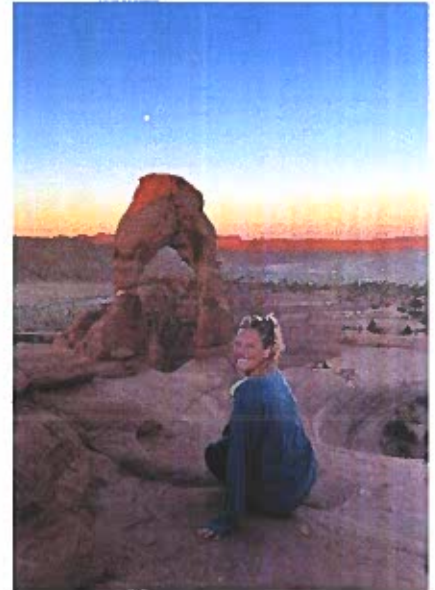

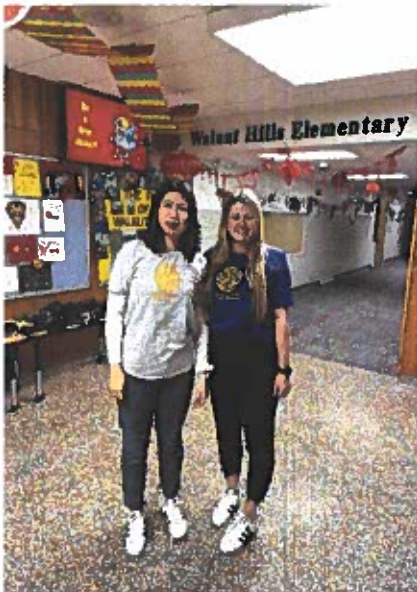
Dear 4th grader and family,
