






There's always been something appealing about an old fashioned whodunnit. Created in 1943, *Clue*, the board game, has been a part of our culture for nearly a century, clearly demonstrating its long standing appeal. Audiences love to get involved through the act of speculating who committed the murder, where, and with what. The armchair detective in you can try to keep up with our long line of colorful suspects (and escalating body count) throughout the show tonight.

The film that this production is based on was released in 1985, memorable most of all for the fact that theaters were shipped different endings of the movie. That meant that you could never quite be sure whodunnit until the end of the film, even if you'd seen it before. The subsequent VHS/DVD releases included all the endings, and this stage play was adapted with all of that in mind. Whether a fan of the film or new to the story, be prepared for quite a few twists and turns along the way. As one of my own favorite movies of all time, I've done my best to combine our own unique vision of the mystery of Boddy Manor with the recognizable moments from the cult classic, bringing some classic board game flavor along the way.
