GREENVILLE PUBLIC SCHOOLS PERFORMING ARTS HALL OF FAME



The Greenville Public Schools Performing Arts Hall of Fame includes alumni students, teachers, administrators and community members that have made a significant contribution to the GPS Performing Arts program or have had a career of notable accomplishment in performing arts.

To be honored with induction, nominees must meet at least three of the following criteria:

- Outstanding talent
- Good Character
- Significant career of note after high school (career professional experience)
- Contribution to the GPS program's success
- Positive contribution in their community
- Recipients will not be eligible for induction until 10 years after graduation from GPS unless special circumstances are present
- Community Members that have made extraordinary contributions to the Performing Arts program
