Dear Whitney Point Community,

Last night the Whitney Point Board of Education held a special meeting to appoint vote counters, conduct a recount and then certify new corrected totals for the 2022 WPCSD Budget Vote.

Many thanks to the Board of Education, the poll counters, and the community for help and patience while we petitioned for the ability to do a recount so that we could correct, for accuracy in the official record, the tally numbers for this year's elections.

You may remember that we discovered small discrepancies after the vote count was complete and the ballot box was sealed on election night. Due to strict education laws regarding the management of budget votes we had to petition the Commissioner of Education in Albany for permission to do a recount and correct the record. Even though it was not likely that the outcome would change, all BOE members and candidates involved petitioned the Commissioner of Education together as there was a shared commitment to making sure exactly correct numbers were recorded for the official record.

Last night our poll counters worked very methodically and implemented multi-layered checks on accuracy to make sure that we had correct numbers for the record.

The results are as follows.


