SUBJECT: PUBLIC SALES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

The Board of Education prohibits commercial sales on school property except when the proceeds of such sales benefit an educational or charitable purpose. In such instances, permission in writing may be requested from the Superintendent of Schools for the use of school property for public sales.

School organizations and parent associations may earn money through fund raising activities or sales on school property subject to the approval of the Superintendent and/or their designee.
