SCHOLARSHIPS GUIDELINES

AWARD COMPONENTS: One scholarship ranging from \$100 to \$500 and individual certificates awarded to a students selected by the Waterford Heritage Day Scholarship Committee.

Institutional scholarships are provided to assist academically-deserving students; however, students with demonstrated need will also be considered. All scholarships and other financial aid already awarded will not be taken into consideration when determining eligibility.

I. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Recipients of the institutional scholarship are required to:

- A. Be enrolling as a first time in college/university/trade school or vocational school.
- B. Pursuing an Associate Degree, Certificate of Completion, or transfer program.
- C. Enrolled for 6-12 credits/hours depending on college/university as full-time.
- D. Maintain satisfactory academic progress as required by your high school.
- E. U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen.
- F. Active and Productive citizen within your community.

II. APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- A. Complete and submit to school counselor, a Waterford Heritage Day Scholarship Application with the items listed below.
- B. Submit and official high school academic transcript from all high schools previously attended.
- C. One page essay about yourself explaining your family background, personal interest, what you plan to study and why you want to further your education.

III. SELECTION RECIPIENTS

Selections will be based on student's overall academic progress, extracurricular activities, leadership skills, and *participation in community activities* (volunteer/non-mandatory).

IV. NOTICE OF AWARDS

Students will be notified by mail of any scholarship award or denial.
