English I

This freshman-level Language Arts class will focus on students' reading, writing, and critical thinking skills. Students will be reading and writing about a wide selection of texts, learning the rules and structures of language, and establishing a strong foundation for critical thinking.

English II (Required)

English III

English III is a junior level class that introduces classic and contemporary American short stories and novels. Students will gain an in-depth knowledge through discussion and written responses focused on themes concerning various types of reading assignments.

English IV (Elective)

This is a senior level course and is offered in conjunction with Missouri Western's dual credit program. Upon completion, the student will gain high school credit as well as three hours of college credit. Students will explore various writing techniques, intervention strategies, sentence structuring and process writing. Students will be required to write a number of papers, both short and long as well as two research papers.
