- Review any updates regarding an Emergency Response System and District Communication Devices to replace CrisisGo.
  - MPS should be the determine our best options. Still interested in exploring the active shooter detection systems.
  - Bob will ask Michelle R about a line item for security funding measures (cameras, fobs, etc)
  - Would Tyler SIS app work for attendance? (**Bob will check with Steven**)
  - Ask Trista to check in with the Chief about NEMLAC STARS input. (Charles and/or Sean will speak with Trista)
- Update on Social Media Tracking Services or App for MPS.
  - Can put a link on our Web page for anonymous reporting. Steven can/will addnotification should go to Principals and Trista possibly Bob.
  - Can Steven push the MPS web site app to the Chrome Books so it's there for students to have access?
  - Who's teaching it to the kids? Add it to the wellness classes./curriculum. Charles talked about the Wellness Committee.
- Recruit additional staff members from each building to attend ALICE institute along with Administrators who have not yet been trained.
  - 5 people going to Hanscome. Try to recruit one more from GM. (Susan will reach out to GM staff)
- Create plan for after school safety and locking of buildings to keep them more secure after hours.
  - Any updates? Bob will ask Michelle to estimate the costs.
  - Hudson uses a parent issued card/fob fingerprint scanner to sign child out. How much does that cost? \$10.00 per card. Does after school pay or school district?
     Sean will talk to Michelle R. to see she can investigate.
- Implement a district staff parking window sticker program.
  - Clearly mark all staff parking lots.
  - Paint arrows indicating flow of traffic at GM staff lot.
  - o Add additional spots? Follow up with Tim.
  - And Metal Chains for GM circle . (adding looking for updates)

- Participation in the Safe Routes to Schools Initiative-
  - Bob made contact -wellness committee will meet with them and invite PTOs January 3rd
- Special Education concerns about locks in sub-separate classroom. Advice from Fire,
  Police, and DPW is needed. Tim has done research and will order more tools.
  - o CASE kids will always lock down.
  - Health plan/safety plan? Individual and lock down plan on IEP?
