ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

Requirements & Summer School Credit

Students and parents are reminded that a high school student must pass seven classes the previous semester to maintain eligibility for athletics. Therefore, a student must pass seven classes this semester to be eligible to compete in athletics in the Fall of 2023.

A student may also use credit earned during summer school to restore Fall semester eligibility. The credit must be in a class required for graduation. Elective courses and correspondence courses cannot count for purposes of restoring eligibility. No more than one credit earned in summer school may be counted toward maintaining

academic eligibility. Please contact Todd Anderson if you have any questions or concerns about the eligibility status of your son/daughter or about using summer school credit to regain eligibility.

Bud Krone/Don Gosen Scholarships / Booster Club Scholarships

The Bearcat Boosters continue to recognize graduating senior athletes for their efforts in athletics at HHS. The Booster Club purchases a plaque for each graduating senior athlete.

The Booster Club also continues to reward one senior female athlete and one senior male athlete who have exhibited good character throughout their high school career both on and off the field of competition by awarding the Don Gosen and Bud Krone Character Excellence Scholarships. These scholarships are valued at \$750 each. The Booster Club also funds four additional scholarships each year for athletes who have excelled in extracurricular activities. Two of these additional scholarships are worth \$750 and two are worth \$500. In order for a student to be eligible for the scholarships, the Booster Club asks the student and parent(s) to work once concession stand together at some point during the school year.
