SPECIAL BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING

March 29, 2022

ROLL CALL – The Raleigh County Board of Education met in special session on Tuesday, March 29, 2022 at 5:00 PM at Tamarack Conference Center with the following members present: President Larry D. Ford, Vice-President Mr. Jack G. Roop, Ms. Marie Hamrick, Dr. Charlotte Hutchens, Mr. Richard V. Snuffer II, and Mr. C. David Price, Secretary.

<u>APPROVAL OF AGENDA</u> – President Ford called the meeting to order. Mr. Snuffer made the motion to approve the agenda. Dr. Hutchens seconded it. The motion passed 5-0.

<u>OPENING REMARKS</u> — President Ford welcomed everyone for attending the LSIC Work Session. Superintendent Price stated the LSIC format would be different than in previous year's past.

NEW BUSINESS -President Ford stated this meeting was called for the second of four (4) LSIC work sessions scheduled for discussion.

- Superintendent Price recognized Independence Middle School, Trap Hill Middle School, Fairdale Elementary School, Marsh Fork Elementary School, Clear Fork Elementary School, Ridgeview Elementary School and Coal City Elementary School for their attendance. Superintendent Price introduced Assistant Superintendent Sandra Sheatsley, who facilitated the LSIC work session by presenting data for the schools based on academic performance, curricular offerings, attendance rates, graduation rates, discipline, community and family involvement.
- Mrs. Sheatsley also asked each school, from the data provided, to discuss, reflect and report on
 what surprised them, what impressed them and what concerns them; along with the needs,
 goals and solutions for each school. Concluding the question and answer period, each board
 member acknowledged and commended the schools on the challenges each school encounters
 on a daily basis.
