On December 17<sup>th</sup> the City Council voted unanimously to approve a new ordinance that will ensure safer traffic flow for drop off and pick up at the Cozad Elementary Schools. The ordinance will take effect on January 3rd.


During the hours listed below 14th street in front the school and C street between 15th street and 14<sup>th</sup> street will be one way and one lane with no street parking. This includes the angle spots on the east side of the school. Anyone that wishes to park and walk your students inside, will need to park in the Elementary School/Methodist Church parking lot located to the east of the school. Any person picking up or dropping off outside of those hours, for example Afterzone, may park normally.

During the first few weeks we will have police and volunteer parents helping with the traffic flow. If you would like to volunteer, please contact me. Eventually we plan to have flashing signs to note the one-way areas. I have included a map on the back of this page to demonstrate the new traffic flow.
