I am writing to you on behalf of the Board of Education; I am happy to announce that on August 22, 2022, at its regular Board of Education meeting, the Stratford Board of Education adopted a new *strategic plan* that will be the guiding instrument for our work over the next couple of years. We are excited and enthusiastic about this strategic plan because it honors our past, with an eye to the future. The strategic plan is intended to be implemented over the course of three years. Annually, we will review our progress in each priority area, against internal and external measures.

Further, it formally adopts, through stakeholder consensus, the Stratford Public Schools Portrait of a Graduate (POG) as the aspirational *Vision* for all Stratford Public Schools students.

- Plan for Future Success. Ensuring a student driven plan that prepares students for postsecondary success

- Family and Community Partnership. Engaging families and strengthening connections with the community.
