Did you know.....If you feel like mosquitoes bite you more often than other people, you may be onto something! Several specific factors can attract mosquitoes, including the carbon dioxide you exhale, your body odor, and your body temperature. A combination of these factors likely makes certain people more attractive to mosquitoes. ~Medline

Ideas for preventing bug bites: use up to 30 percent DEET or 10 percent picaridin in sprays. Avoid spraying your child's hands and face and don't reapply unless needed. You can also spritz it on top of clothes for added protection.

Ice can help if they do get a bite. You can also try applying calamine or hydrocortisone lotion/cream. Discourage scratching as bacteria under nails can cause infection and make the bites worse.

Appropriate footwear reminder—sandals, slides, crocs, flip flops are all fun summer shoes, but children at school are very active during recesses and PE classes. If your child chooses to wear these type shoes to school, please remind them to pack sneakers as well so they can safely participate in PE and free time. Thank you!

We are constantly reminding students to drink lots of water. Please remind them to bring a water bottle daily. We have water refill stations at school. Staying hydrated helps students to stay healthy and focused during their school days. If they balk at plain water, try adding some fruits or even herbs like mint to try to encourage them to drink drink drink like we say to them every day!
