BATH AREA FOOD BANK

THE BATH AREA FOOD BANK is a great resource for families in Bath, West Bath, Arrowsic, Georgetown, Phippsburg, and Woolwich. EVERYONE IS WELCOME and there are NO financial guidelines if you need groceries for your family. The Food Pantry is open Tuesday 4pm-6pm and Thursday 12pm-2pm. The food bank will supply you with canned goods, dairy items, frozen meats, baked goods, and you will be able to shop for produce, more baked goods, Panera, Starbucks, toiletries, and much more. Meals are served ‘to go’ on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday 12:00-1:30. One meal per person. The food bank offers a hot meal each day and a frozen meal to take home. The food bank will also be offering ‘kid’s meals’ during the summer months that will include a meal and a breakfast. Follow the Bath Area Food Bank on facebook to get weekly updates on offerings.
