The MTSS Specialist will support the effective implementation of the district's multi-tiered system of support (MTSS) at the K-12 school level. The MTSS Specialist will collaborate with school staff in coordinating a tiered intervention model across academics with special emphasis on behavior, and social-emotional learning (SEL). This includes assessment, instruction, progress monitoring, and evaluation of intervention programs with the goal of increasing student achievement.

### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES:**

- Plan and oversee 504 Plans for Y5-8th grade students.
- Plan and oversee Kid Talks (child studies) for Y5-12th grade students.
- Support School Leadership Team Coaches and School Leadership Teams (SLTs) to ensure MTSS processes, protocols, and plans are implemented with fidelity and meet the needs of students.

- Communicate the needs of School Leadership Teams with the district MTSS Coordinator.
- Support grade-level and building-level decision-making based on MTSS data and outcomes.
- Support and coach classroom teachers on best practices for Tier 1 behavior instruction and Tier 2 behavior intervention.
- Provide direct instruction with small groups and individual students as needed.
- Work collaboratively with administration, 31N counselor, and social workers to provide assistance with de-escalating student behavior and reintegrating students back into the classroom.
- Support student attendance and truancy.
